Criteria for Pre-Cleared Initiatives by the BoD


□ Initiatives considered aligned with the mandate of GFoRSS, i.e. to promote Food Regulatory Sciences.

- Includes learning initiatives in any are related to Food Regulatory Sciences, from food laboratory initiatives to risk analysis and regulatory policy development.
- Includes the dissemination of best practices and capacity
 / competency development initiatives in Food Regulatory
 Science:
 - Seminars, workshops, etc.
- □Includes investments in methodology development associated with Food Regulatory Science:
 - Consumption data collection, exposure assessment methods, economic / societal impact assessment

Other Considerations

□Budgetary aspects:

- Above threshold for a single initiative: \$50K, \$100K ?
- □Strategic nature:
 - Position of the organization in a region of the world or in a discipline.
- □Long-term impact on the organization:
 - Major investment in resources for the upcoming period.

- Aligned with the mandate of GFoRSS (as expressed in previous slides)
- □Funded from external source : does not e reserve from GFoRSS / GFoRSS internal fu
- □ Follows previous practices of GFoRSS Pro_ management i.e. overhead of at least 10%
- □\$ Threshold set at \$100 KUSD
- Time Commitment /duration should not exceed 18 months
