








NIVS Strategy 2022 – 2025

- ☐ Embrace **transparency** in food regulatory decision-making, operations and management.
- Description:

 Emphasize the independence of NIVS as a food competent authority protecting consumers and creating a fair environment for food trade.
- ☐ Promote **impartial** treatment amongst stakeholders and constituents of NIVS









Modernize Suriname's Food Safety Legislation and Develop Supporting Regulatory Frameworks

- ☐ Develop and consult on policy underpinning the new food safety legislation.
- □ Draft a modernized Suriname Food Act and support its discussion and adoption by Parliament.
- ☐ Develop a regulatory regime for food import management and Control.
- □ Develop a regulatory regime for minimum food safety requirements of Food Business Operators.
- ☐ Develop food contaminant regulatory requirements.







Promote Food Safety Practices by Surinamese Food Producers and Operators

- Develop a general food safety awareness campaign:
 - For food producers.
 - For consumers.
- Develop tailored guidance for enhanced food safety practices:
 - Prerequisite programs.
 - Preventive controls.
- Develop and deploy guidance and associated training on Good Agriculture Practice (GAP) adapted for Suriname.
- ☐ Develop guidance on food labelling practices.







Engage with Domestic and International Partners and Stakeholders to Promote Suriname's Position as a Leading Food and Agrifood Producer.

Activities:

☐ Enable effective preparation and participation of Surinamese delegations in Codex Committee proceedings.



- □Play a leading role in the operationalization of the Caribbean Taskforce on Food Safety and support Caribbean Food Regulatory Convergence.
- □ Support the development and enabling of food safety and food regulatory science capacity building in collaboration with CAHFSA that serves NIVS / Suriname's food regulatory programs.







Build a Dynamic and Professional Workforce and Enable Effective Food Regulatory Operations

- Develop an introductory training for professional food safety staff to use as part of a professional recruitment strategy.
- Engage with technical institutes and other academic institutions in Suriname to support the identification of talent and promote food safety regulatory jobs.
- ☐ Develop a Safe and Favorable environment for NIVS workforce to operate and develop
- ☐ Develop working conditions, accountabilities, and rules
- ☐ Develop a code of conduct for NIVS staff.
- ☐ Identify and fill key food regulatory operational positions within the first 12 months.
- ☐ Develop and deploy NIVS on-boarding program supported by a continued education program.
- ☐ Develop a competency-based approach to HR management.
- □ Develop Information and Communication Tools (ICTs) to support effective food regulatory operations, including registration of establishments and the decision-making process.









Build a Science Capacity Serving Stakeholders and NIVS

- ☐ Enhance food laboratory operations with extension of food testing capacities to address the needs of Suriname's food production sectors.
- Develop a food safety science capacity to anchor NIVS Decision-making in Food Risk Analysis:
 - E.g. risk assessment capacity and science evaluation operations.
- ☐ Promote NIVS scientific teams to be part of international food science regulatory networks.
- ☐ Sustain infrastructure and equipment investments to support NIVS food safety regulatory operations.
