- ☐ Sustained Contribution to Codex Electronic Working Groups:
 - Prioritization of Agenda Items of Interest and Support to contribution with Data to ensure Relevance of Standards to Countries of the Region







Areas of Intervention

Four Main Areas of Intervention

- A. Awareness Raising: Development of Training Material and Delivery of Incremental Capacity Development
- **B. Development of a "Pool of Experts":** from countries of the region, which can be drawn upon to support Codex Delegations in Development of Positions for Codex Meetings
- C. Organization of Coordination Meetings / Events in Support for CCNASWP Chair
 - ✓ Continued Support to Regional Standards Development
- **D. Investment in National competencies and capacities** Strengthening of National Codex Contact Points.
