Future Activities of the Arab Codex

Initiative

- Follow-up preparation for the meetings of the priority committees of the Codex Alimentarius in the Arab region,
- Supporting the work and activities of the Arab e-working groups and sharing the outcomes of their meetings with the rest of the Arab countries' contact points in Codex
- * Training and qualification of Arab delegations participating in codex meetings
- Use of IT applications (e-platforms, databases,...)
- Preparation The participation of Arab countries in the meeting of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC 46).
- Preparing studies based on scientific foundations and supporting food safety and fair trade for food products,
- Coordinating the Arab position in CCEXEC and strengthening the presence of Arab countries in the leadership positions of the Codex Alimentarius and highlighting its leading role in decision-making
- Hosting the meetings of the Codex Alimentarius Committees concerned with sectors of interest to the Arab region.
- Work and coordinate with the CCNE Regional Coordinating Committee for the Near East to support the work of the Codex Alimentarius
 Commission
- Continuing to prepare CRD documents to be included in the documents of the Codex Committees to highlight the positions of the Arab countries
