### Items developed for discussion/consideration/action

- Management of unsupported compounds without public health concern scheduled for periodic review (internal procedure)
- National registration of pesticides to facilitate scheduling of compounds for periodic reviews
- Discussion paper on an analysis of previous decisions by CCPR to establish MRLs for tomato and pepper and to present a proposal to CCPR55 to establish corresponding MRLs in eggplant
- Coordination of work between CCPR and CCRVDF: Establishment of harmonized/single MRLs for compounds with dual use (Terms of Reference, future work)
- ➤ Enhancement of the operational procedure of CCPR and JMPR: Opportunities, challenges, and recommendations on next steps
- Establishment of MRLs/MLs for Ethylene Oxide (EtO)

Options for efficient data support that could be addressed by Codex, FAO/WHO, JMPR, governments and industry to further assist countries in implementing the Management of unsupported compounds without public health concern scheduled for periodic review
