Rule IV of the Rules of Procedure - Role of the coordinator country

<p>Assist and coordinate the work of the Committee in their region in the preparation of draft standards, guidelines and other recommendations for submission to the Commission.</p>	<p>-RC can convene meetings, so country members are reminded of tasks at hand -RC should remember the main output or objectives needed from previous cc meetings and convene or call a meeting. The meeting can discuss followings above, once finalized, submit to secretariat and then to commission.</p>
<p>Assist the Executive Committee and the Commission, as required, by advising them of the views of countries and recognized regional intergovernmental and non-government organizations in their respective regions on matters under discussion or of interest.</p>	<p>-Through CCNASWP reports and also through specific related issues to its own committees, regional coordinator should be the responsible voice to represent the region, otherwise, use the focal point to put issues forward. -another issue to take into consideration is the regional coordinator handover</p>

Section V of PM – Terms of reference of FAO/WHO Regional Committees

<p>Identify problems and needs concerning standards and food control</p>	<p>-Through Roundtable meetings where part of the agenda is an item that can address these issues if there are needs for it and also CCNASWP meeting - no scientific facility to pack up current data - not enough manpower due to government undervaluing the benefits of Fiji.</p>
<p>Promote Contacts and Mutual Exchange of Information on Proposed Regulatory Initiatives</p>	
<p>Support to Enhancement of Food Control Infrastructure</p>	<p>-CTF programmes -recommendation of capacity building programmes on Codex especially increase expert levels in the region and raise awareness</p>



<p>Recommends the development of worldwide standards for products of interest to the region, including products considered by the Committee to have an international market potential in the future.</p>	<p>-as per usual procedure where one of the country members can put forward an item of interest for standardization and the committee can go through the 8 steps of developing the standard.</p>
<p>Supports the development of Regional Standards</p>	<p>-going through the usual procedure of developing standards without discrimination or cause of obstruction</p>
<p>Draws to the attention the of the Commission any aspects of its work of particular significance to the region</p>	<p>-Regional coordinator and focal point can advocate on this to the commission and have to be powerful in that aspect</p>
<p>Promotes Various Aspects of Coordination in the Region, as Entrusted by the CAC</p>	
<p>Promotes Use of Codex Standards in the Region</p>	<p>-convening of meetings that addresses priority issues and that each member should be responsible to be present. -Will have to consider which coordinations can be done physically, virtually and hybrid mode.</p>
