

:A:	01	Further Review for Clarity  Conduct additional review of standard texts to ensure clarity and consistency in conveying information on permitted additives.
	02	Continuation of Alignment Process  Continue the alignment process exercise, considering potential changes in food categories and additive provisions.
<u>S</u> .	03	Addressing Contradictions  Address contradictions between existing notes to avoid confusion and achieve coherence within the standards.
	04	Improving Clarity and Coherence:  Arab Codex delegations can contribute to enhancing the clarity, coherence, and effectiveness of regional commodity standards
