What is Codex?

The Codex Alimentarius Commission (Codex) is:


An intergovernmental body established in 1963



Currently consists of 189 members

188 member countries

1 member organization (EU)



More Observers than Members



240 Observers

- 59 IGOs
- 165 NGOs
 - 16 UN



Solicit Stakeholder Input in Shaping Codex Positions

Consultation is a core activity of the CCP

In order to **facilitate consultation** and **avoid overwhelming stakeholders** with unwanted
documentation, it is the **responsibility of the CCP**:

- to identify which groups are interested in what issues; and
- to determine the mechanism for consultation.



Solicit Stakeholder Input – A Coordination Mechanism

Countries are free to choose their own national coordination mechanism.

To facilitate the consultation process and to ease some of the workload of the Codex Contact Point, many countries have established a **National Codex Committee** (**NCC**) or an equivalent structure.




Experience / Models of Engagement

- ☐ National Codex Committees, Include Non-Government Partners, for example: Morocco, Egypt
 - National Codex Committee Used as a Forum for Engagement and to Solicit Stakeholder Input
- □Other forums are dedicated to Stakeholder Engagement e.g., Public Meetings, Conferences, Workshops, Dedicated Meetings
 - Consumer Organizations
 - Industry Organizations
 - Health Professional Groups
 - Academia


