INTRODUCTION

Food additives are chemical substances added to food for the purpose of exerting a technological effect, such as a change in colour, texture or microbiological load.

Food additives are subject to a strong level of oversight by most food regulatory jurisdictions before being allowed for use in conjunction with food production. Before being allowed for use, additives are examined for their safety and for their technological effectiveness. It is only when both criteria are fulfilled, meaning when the use is justified, and the safety is established that conditions of such use are approved by food regulators.

The conditions of review and approval of food additives adopted by most food regulators internationally are based upon the guidance provided by the Joint Expert Committee on Food Additives (JECFA), which is a risk assessment body, managed by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations.

This workshop co-organized by the Federation Agri-Food Industries – Fédération Nationale de l'Agroalimentaire (FENAGRI) in Morocco, in Partnership with the National Bureau of Food Safety – Office National de Sécurité Sanitaire des produits alimentaires (ONSSA) and the Global Food Regulatory Science Society (GFoRSS)

The workshop aims to review international best practice related to food additive review and approval, including the JECFA approach as well as approaches followed by international regulators to assess and approve food additives. It also aims to share the experience of ONSSA as the leading food regulatory body in Morocco in the review and approval of food additives and to present developments in the management of food additives resulting from scientific advances in international food regulation.
