Objective


 Develop a Discussion Paper to be submitted to the 34th session of CCGP, that will be held from 2 to 6 June 2025, 2025 – in Lille, France.

EWG Outputs

1- Develop a Discussion Paper with the aim to:

- review the use of "reservations" in Codex Alimentarius proceedings (i.e. CCCF, CCFA, CCPR and CCRVDF), examining their significance and potential impact on the relevance and understanding of Codex standards.
- have a clear understanding on the use of reservations / encourage more effective and informed use of "reservations" in the framework of Codex proceedings.
- be submitted to CCGP 34th session after endorsement by Arab/CCNE countries.

2- Develop a survey

• about the use of "reservations", to gain an overview about the current status of the use and understanding of "reservations" by Codex delegations.
