WORKING GROUP

I. NAME

Working Group on the Development of Arab Requirements for the Acceptance of Gluten Quantitative Methods.

II. MISSION

To establish Arab requirements for the acceptance of quantitative gluten testing methods applied to gluten-free prepackaged foods and inherently gluten-free foods.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES

- To provide expert advice for the development of Arab requirements for the acceptance of quantitative gluten testing methods.
- To report back to the Arab Section Executive Committee, which will handle communication with:
 - the Arab Industrial Development Standardization and Mining Organization (AIDSMO) and its Arab Technical Committee for Food Products Standards (TC9) and,
 - the AOAC INTERNATIONAL Gluten & Food Allergens Program.
- o To make recommendations for expanding the objectives of the current program.
